Doctors and scientists throughout Europe have also positively been able to link the potential spread of the Zika virus to Great Britain's exit from the EU.


Meanwhile, millions of voters in Great Britain are demanding another referendum, claiming that the recent vote was flawed.

DID YOU KNOW?

1- Among the vast number of items that Meriwether Lewis supplied the Lewis and Clark Expedition with was 193 pounds of dried "portable soup" to be eaten when fresh game was scarce. To this day, nobody knows exactly what went into the "portable soup," but Lewis greatly believed in its nutritive value. To say the least, it would become the most hated thing by the men on the expedition.

2- Sixty-Five U.S. Deputy Marshals were killed in the line of duty between 1875 and 1891 while enforcing the law for "hanging Judge" Isaac C. Parker of Fort Smith, Arkansas.

3- Bannack, Montana Sheriff Henry Plummer secretly led a band of outlaws who robbed or killed more than a hundred victims. His hidden life was eventually discovered and in 1864, he and his gang were hanged by Montana vigilantes. In 1876, the lawless town of Deadwood, South Dakota averaged a murder a day.
