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## MEXICAN PRESIDENT OFFERS HELP IN U.S. PLANS TO BLOCKADE CHINESE MAN- MADE ISLANDS IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA

### MEXICANS OFFER TO LOAN ITS NEW BORDER WALL TO THE U.S.

Washington - January 26, 2017

The new U. S. President, Donald Grump, has ruled out using military force or a naval blockade in an effort to deprive China of use of its newly created islands in the South China Sea.

Mr. Grump announced today that he intended to build a wall around the islands instead and said that the Chinese would be expected to pay for it.

"They can actually make the walls in China" the President stated. "This would be a lot cheaper than building them in the U.S. and then shipping them over to the South China Sea".

Upon hearing this news, Mexican President, Antonio de Padua María Severino López de Santa Anna y Pérez de Lebrón Enrique Peña Nieto immediately contacted President Grump and offered to lend their wall to the U.S. and at no cost.

"We know that it's important to the United

States that the US-Mexican wall be maintained, but we promise, crossing our hearts, that we will be very good and not step over the border, not even once, while it eez on loan to the Americanos for its South China Sea project" pledged the Mexican President.

Placing the wall overseas has not been readily received in the United States though, with many believing that the Mexicans will not honor their word and stay in Mexico while the wall is on loan.

One such man, from Texas, identified as Bubba RadNick, called his local radio station and complained about the Mexican offer.

Roughly translated, it says "Go for it, you glorified real estate agent"


### TPP TO GO AHEAD DESPITE U.S. AND PACIFIC NATIONS PULL-OUT
